that Ventnor Town Council oppose this application. Whilst accepting the change of use to a restaurant, the Committee oppose this application on the following grounds:-

- o over-development, in particular the ground floor seating area to the rear;
- o given the area available for customer seating, it is felt that the kitchen area is inadequate;
- similarly, the toilet provision should provide for separate male and female toilets to reflect the size of the venue; and
- o given that there is a high proportion of flats in this area, the opening hours are excessive.
