a) P/00301/18: 59 NEWPORT ROAD

b) P/00282/18: LONGWOOD LEDGE, BONCHURCH SHUTE

c) P/00293/18: MONKS BAY COTTAGE, THE CLIFF PATH, BONCHURCH

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council supports this application and considers the proposal to be well designed and the setting of the property into the bank renders it unobtrusive.

d) P/00252/18: 5 Pier Street

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council opposes this application on the basis of the accommodation being too small and seemingly does not comply with minimum standards according to the document from the Department for Communities and Local Government (March 2015), Technical Housing Standards – Nationally Described Space Standard.

e) P/00233/18: Seven Sisters, Seven Sisters Road

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council opposes this application. The mass of the proposed building is visually intrusive and could be on a much smaller footprint for the accommodation it provides. This general area is known to be unstable, therefore an Engineer's report on the stability of the site should be provided.
