a) P/00681/18: LAND TO REAR OF 77-87 GILLS CLIFF ROAD

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council sees no reason to oppose this application and it is a welcome solution to the potential issues surrounding the fencing of a public footpath.

b) P/00664/18: GAIETY AMUSEMENTS, ESPLANADE

It was resolved, with one abstention: that Ventnor Town Council strongly supports this application. A welcome enhancement to the Esplanade by restoring an historic landmark building of a distinctive shape and character. This application appears to meet the requirements of the Island Core Strategy DM2 Design Quality for New Development and DM11 Historic and Built Environment.

c) P/00654/18: POST OFFICE COUNTERS LTD, LOWTHERVILLE POST OFFICE
