# 52/18 GENERAL POWER OF COMPETENCE

  - the Town Clerk must hold one of the recognised qualifications including that for the General Power of Competence.
- b) The Town Clerk confirmed that these criteria are complied with at this time.

It was proposed by Councillor Tony Marvin, seconded by Councillor Stephen Cockett and resolved unanimously that:

Ventnor Town Council notes that as it meets the conditions of eligibility required to exercise the General Power of Competence as set out in the Parish Councils (General Power of Competence) (Prescribed Conditions) Order 2012 it continues to be eligible for its use.
