ITEM SUBJECT

1) APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

3) PUBLIC FORUM

There were two members of the public present

Judy & Nick Ballanger, residents of Steephill Court Road raised concerns about the three chalets that have been built and campsite activities at Ventnor Botanic Garden site.

4) **PLANNING APPLICATIONS**

a) 21/02261/FUL: ST AUGUSTINE'S VILLA, ESPLANADE

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council strongly oppose this application regarding the egress from the site, as was mentioned by Island Roads. This does not appear to comply with policy DM2. However, the proposed pergola extension is acceptable and the Committee would have supported this element of the proposal if it had been submitted as a separate application.

b) 21/02402/FUL: 5 SOUTHGROVE TERRACE, SOUTHGROVE ROAD

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council see no reason to oppose this application, but concerns are raised about potential land slippage.

c) 21/02439/HOU: CARFAX, UNDERCLIFF DRIVE

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council strongly support this application and feel that the proposal is a significant improvement.

d) 21/02393/HOU: 32 ZIG ZAG ROAD

It was unanimously resolved:

that Ventnor Town Council strongly oppose this application based on accessibility onto Ocean View Road as mentioned in the comments of Island Roads' document and which is contrary to Policy DM2. Additionally, there is no provision made for storage of refuse.
