# **REPORT 5/21**

The purpose of this Report is provide Members with information on the operation of the 31 Bus Service

## No. **DETAILS**

## I) BACKGROUND

- a) At its meeting of 10 February the Town Council unanimously resolved to commit to continuing the service on the basis of two days a week for six months with a review after three months.
- b) However government guidance required the termination of the service at the end of March and it ended temporarily on Friday 3 April.
- c) It was then able to restart with risk assessment, signage and social distancing measures in place on 18 August, running on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week.
- d) The Assets & Services Group advised that the documentation from a full three months' operation of the service be available as the basis for a review.
- e) That documentation was available in time for the Group's meeting of 15 December and it saw no reason to discontinue the service in view of the current Covid-related consequences for residents, the fact that there were only three full months of the current financial year remaining and that discussions about a possible alternative service for 2021/22 are ongoing.

### 2) FINANCES

a) The information about the three month period of September to November is summarised in the following table:

- b) The income from the service is the total of the £1.25 half of the advertised fare per passenger journey recovered from the Isle of Wight Council in respect of those qualifying for free bus travel on the basis of numbers supplied by the operator monthly.
- c) The cost relates to the operator's charge of  $\pounds 90$  per day of operation.

### 3) RECOMMENDATION

The Town Council is recommended to agree to the continuation of the service at the current level for the remainder of the 2020/21 financial year,
