

# **TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

**REPORT 62/13** 

12 AUGUST 2013

The purpose of this report is to inform Members of major changes affecting the No. 31 Bus Service.

#### No. DETAIL

### I) INTRODUCTION

- a) Following changes to services by Southern Vectis, the Isle of Wight Council introduced a funding regime for locally operated substitute services in areas where local volunteers were able to propose appropriate arrangements.
- b) The local service provided by the No. 31 Bus is operated by Ventnor Community Bus CIC, established in January 2012, with leadership by the then Member of Ventnor Town Council Jim Morgan.
- c) The service is operated through an arrangement with Island Taxis' Ken Bailey and funded by the Isle of Wight Council.
- d) Ventnor Town Council has provided a banking function for the service since its inception, receiving monthly payments for it from the Isle of Wight Council and disbursing the funds through invoices provided by Island Taxis.

### 2) CHANGES

- a) Jim Morgan has informed us that the driver will be resigning from the arrangement for personal reasons for a period likely to be of several months from about the end of September.
- b) Jim Morgan also said that the Ventnor Community Bus CIC is likely to cease operating in the near future.

# 3) TOWN COUNCIL

- a) The Town Council has no direct involvement with or responsibility for the operation of the No. 31 Bus.
- b) The Town Council is asked to consider whether there is any action it might want to initiate in response to the changes identified in 2 above.
