4)	CHRIS ASHMAN The Isle of Wight Council's Director of Regeneration has offered to attend this meeting to discuss the recently published Regeneration Strategy for the Island.

6)	BONIFACE FIELDS: ST CATHERINE'S SCHOOL St Catherine's School are proposing to seek a lease from the Isle of Wight Council for a small area of the site around the astro turf during school hours.

8)	WATER FOUNTAIN The Assets & Services Working Group has a proposal for renovating this significant Esplanade feature involving a grant application to Down to the Coast.
