Considering the recommendations of the Public Buildings Working Group on the revised draft for leases of the four car parks now managed by the Town Council.

- 7) VENTNOR LIBRARY
Following the decision of the Isle of Wight Council's Executive that Ventnor Library will join those of Cowes and Freshwater in the new category of Partnership Libraries the Town Council will discuss its approach to the partnership negotiations.

Following the decision of the Isle of Wight Council's Executive to invite Town and Parish Councils to submit Expressions of Interest in taking over the remaining Public Toilets in their area, the Town Council will discuss its response.

A draft Heads of Terms for a Tenancy at Will for the Town Council's use of the building has been submitted by the Bank's property department.
