ITEM	SUBJECT
4)	<p>FINANCE REPORT</p> <p>The usual report will be circulated with the papers for this meeting and be available on the web site from noon on 8 October. Report 83/15 refers.</p>
5)	<p>ANNUAL RETURN</p> <p>Report 84/15 for this meeting records signing off of the Annual Return for 2014/15 and has a copy of the document attached.</p>
6)	<p>SALISBURY GARDENS YEAR 1 ACCOUNTS</p> <p>As the first full year of Salisbury Gardens' operations ended on 30 September, accounts for the period will form the basis of Report 85/15 for Members' consideration and comment.</p>
7)	<p>COUNCIL TAX REDUCTION SCHEME</p> <p>The Working Group on these proposals was asked to consider them in more detail and bring recommendations for a response to the current consultation on them to this meeting.</p>
8)	<p>PLANNING ENFORCEMENT PROPOSAL</p> <p>A draft proposal from the Isle of Wight Association of Local Councils for strengthening enforcement of planning decisions by employing an additional officer.</p>
9)	<p>INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION 2015</p> <p>The IMD 2015 has just been published and Report 88/15 will provide an initial analysis of its significance for the town and the Island.</p>
10)	<p>DEVOLUTION PROPOSALS</p> <p>Last month's Town Council Meeting asked that this be returned to at the October meeting.</p>
11)	<p>GROUNDS MAINTENANCE</p> <p>The Public Buildings Working Groups is recommending an additional expenditure of approximately £400 to restore a major hedge to a state in which it can be routinely maintained.</p>
12)	<p>PIGEON NUISANCE</p> <p>Councillor Harry Rees will introduce this item prompted by concerns about damage being caused in the High Street.</p>
13)	<p>IWALC REPORT</p> <p>Councillor Harry Rees will report on the latest developments within the Isle of Wight Association of Local Councils (IWALC).</p>
14)	<p>TOWN CLERKS' REPORT</p> <p>As usual, this report records activity that has been progressed by the Clerks but does not need formal Town Council decision at this time.</p>
