5	ANNUAL ACCOUNTS The Accounts for the Financial Year are already available for the financial year 2014/15 in their usual Receipts and Payments format.
6	TRANSPARENCY CODE As the Town Council's annual turnover is now in excess of £200,000, compliance with the Department for Communities and Local Government's Transparency Code 2015 is required.
7	GROUNDS MAINTENANCE A report on the Grounds Maintenance Contract for delivering the Town Council's new responsibility for Grounds Maintenance.
8	OUR PLACE PROGRAMME An update on the Programme and some of the elements of it still to be delivered.
9	SAFEGUARDING POLICY The expanding Youth Offer programme requires the Town Council to have an updated Safeguarding Policy. A draft for one has been prepared by its staff and will be attached to Report 36/15 for Members' consideration and adoption.
10	HEALTH & WELLBEING STRATEGY The Town Council has the opportunity to comment on the recently published draft Health & Wellbeing Strategy.
