4	<p>FINANCE REPORT</p> <p>The usual report will be circulated with the papers for this meeting and be available on the web site from Friday morning.</p>
5	<p>ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT FUND APPLICATION</p> <p>An update on progress with the application to the Isle of Wight Council for the advertised allocation to Ventnor that is intended by the Town Council to support its Economic Development Project</p>
6	<p>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT</p> <p>This sets out alternative funding proposals for the project.</p>
7	<p>LEASE OF OUTFIT LAND</p> <p>The Town Council is asked to approve the lease for the land supplied by the Isle of Wight Council and to determine whether it will accept it as a standard lease for these purposes wishes to take legal advice before doing so.</p>
