2	CO-OPTION OF A TOWN COUNCILLOR The unanimous recommendation from the informal group for appointment will be presented for adoption following which the new Town Councillor will be invited by the Mayor to the table and asked by the Town Clerk to sign the usual Declaration.
4	ISLE OF ARTS Chris Bonney will give a short presentation on the plans for this year's Isle of Arts Festival.
6	FINANCE REPORT The usual report will be circulated with the papers for this meeting and be available on the web site from Friday morning.
7	BUDGET & PRECEPT 2012/13 The adjusted budget and notes will have been previously circulated and is due for adoption at this meeting together with the precept necessary to fund it.
8	ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT FUND APPLICATION Following the informal budget setting meeting, the project proposal has been submitted to the Isle of Wight Council in order to comply with their deadline for applications of 17 February. It now needs to be supported by a formal minute of support for the project from this meeting.
9	GREEN VENTNOR Councillor David George will introduce this item and ask for decisions on each of the projects identified on the Agenda.
10	STAFFING COMMITTEE & WORKING GROUP The Town Clerk's paper recommending changes to the Staffing Committee's Terms of Reference and the appointment of two Working Groups will have been previously circulated to Members.
