

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

9 JULY 2012

The purpose of this Report is to invite Members to adopt a new Code of Conduct and provide information on the new Register of Interests.

No. DETAIL

I) BACKGROUND

- a) Signing up to a Code of Conduct is a requirement of Membership of any Town and Parish Council.
- b) Following the government's decision to remove the Standards Board for England and its links with principal authorities, there is a requirement to adopt a new Code of Conduct agreed locally.
- c) The National Association of Local Council's (NALC) issued a proposed draft for adoption and the Isle of Wight Council circulated a draft of their own as a proposed standard for the Isle of Wight Council and all the Islands Town and Parish Councils.
- d) The Isle of Wight Association of Local Councils (IWALC) discussed the relative merits of both and entered into direct discussions with the Isle of Wight Council's Monitoring Officers.
- e) In the event, the advantages of an Island standard Code have been acknowledged.

2) NEW CODE OF CONDUCT

- a) A copy of the proposed new Code of Conduct, adapted for Ventnor Town Council is attached with this report for Members' consideration.
- b) The matter is urgent as the legal requirement is for a new Code of Conduct to be adopted by 1 July 2012.

3) REGISTER OF INTERESTS

- a) Also attached is the Isle of Wight Council's redrafting for a new Register of Interests to take account of the requirement for the interests of Members' partners to be included.
- b) The new regulation also requires that Registers of Interests for all Members are posted to the Isle of Wight Council's web site and the Ventnor Town Council web site.
