



CRAB & LOBSTER SIGN REQUEST

The purpose of this paper is to ask Members to consider a request from the landlords of the Crab & Lobster to erect a directional sign in the Town Centre.

No. DETAILS

1) INTRODUCTION

- a) The landlords of the Crab & Lobster, David and Dianne Weedon, are concerned that their site at the bottom of Grove Road needs Town Centre signage to make residents and visitors aware of its presence.
- b) They have requested the Town Council's permission to erect a suitable sign on land managed by the Town Council at the bottom of Spring Hill.

2) THE REQUEST

- a) The request is for permission to install a directional sign just behind the low wall at the bottom of Springhill as in the image below.
- b) The proposed sign would say 'the Crab & Lobster' with 'Cask Ales & Good Food'.

The Crab & Lobster TAP - Ventnor

Request to Ventnor Town Council for street signage to the restaurant/pub premises, situated as shown below just behind the lower wall to Steep Hill gardens. The sign would be visible mainly to people travelling up the high street towards the top end of town and attract them to our premises. The sign, supports fixings and maintenance would be provided by the Crab & Lobster provided permission was given by the council. As we are a local business serving both local residents and tourists from many parts of the world, this would help our business enormously by informing people of our location and services, and our continued contribution to the local Ventnor economy and support of local tourism. We hope that the council will give us our support and allow this request to proceed.
