

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

REPORT 77/18

The purpose of this paper is to recommend the Town Council to progress the Asset & Services Working Group's proposals for the restoration of the Esplanade Water Fountain.

No. **DETAILS**

I) BACKGROUND

a) The notes of local historian, the late Fay Hewitt Brown, on the Fountain record its origins as follows:

Temperance was foremost in the minds of many people in the late 1880s and early 1900s and locally the Ventnor and Bonchurch Temperance Society was formed. Mr. John Newton Cater, a member of the Local Board (forerunner of the Ventnor Urban District Council) was the Hon. Secretary in 1883 when it was proposed to erect a "handsome granite drinking fountain." The money was raised by public subscription and the fountain was built by Ingram's.

- b) Its deteriorating condition was discussed by the Assets & Services Group in March last year and it was agreed to obtain a quotation for its restoration.
- c) The quotation, from Wight Stonemasonry Ltd is attached to this Report.

2) PROGRESS

- a) No action was taken at that time as there was no budgetary provision for it and it was agreed to leave progress with the restoration until this year.
- b) Informal discussions with the Down to the Coast fund have indicated that an approach to assist with funding for the works would be appropriate.
- c) Down to the Coast requires 40% match funding for projects and on the basis of last year's quotation that would require a Town Council contribution of £1,039 against a grant of £1,559.
- d) There may well be an increase in the May 2017 cost if the work proceeds this year and the Assets & Services Group wants to consider including addition works to the structure.
- e) The next deadline for the consideration of applications is 13 October.

3) RECOMMENDATION

The Town Council is recommended to:

- i) ask its Clerk to submit a funding application to Down to the Coast for the restoration works up to the maximum grant level of \$5,000 on the basis of updated estimates;
- ii) agree to fund the 40% match funding requirement if the application is successful.
