



ESPLANADE NOTICEBOARD

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

The purpose of this paper is to consider the options for the future of the Esplanade Noticeboard.

No. DETAIL

1) BACKGROUND

- a) In Minute 105/15 of its meeting of 10 August 2015 the Town Council agreed to take over responsibility for the Esplanade Noticeboard and agreed an amount of £600 for its refurbishment.
 - b) Detailed investigation of the condition of the Noticeboard has revealed that it needs actual replacement rather than the originally anticipated refurbishment.

2) REPLACEMENT

- a) Councillor Jim Toogood will outline the options for its replacement and the reasons why that is necessary at the meeting.
 - b) It may be possible to retain the existing posts and purchase a new Board.
 - c) Consequently the cost will fall within the range of £2,500 - £3,000.

3) RECOMMENDATION

The Town Council is recommended to agree a replacement cost of up to £3,000 in view of the significance of the Noticeboard for both residents and visitors.
