



The purpose of this paper is to update Members on developments in their discussion of the future development of the Isle of Wight Association of Local Councils since their informal meeting of 31 August.

No. DETAIL

1) BACKGROUND

- a) Following the Town Council's discussion of the challenges facing the Isle of Wight Association of Local Councils (IWALC) – the umbrella body for the Islands' Town and Parish Councils – at its meeting of 8 August it was agreed to arrange a meeting with its representatives to discuss matters further on an informal basis.
 - b) The meeting took place at Salisbury Gardens on the evening of 31 August when seven Members and the Clerks had a constructive discussion with IWALC's Chair Gill Kennett and Secretary Gill Jolliff.
 - c) The discussion was based on a presentation that is attached to this Report for information.
 - d) At the conclusion of the meeting the Mayor and Clerk were invited to attend the next IWALC meeting to discuss some of the outcomes.
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2) PROPOSAL

- a) The invitation to the IWALC Executive meeting of 15 September has subsequently been confirmed in an email from Gill Kennett.
 - b) It has been agreed that we will provide a short presentation including a draft proposal for changes to the way IWALC is currently structured and the rationale for it that has been previously discussed with Gill Kennett.
 - c) The presentation is likely to include slides 2,4,5,6,8 and 9 of the presentation attached to this Report with two additional slides setting out a draft for an alternative model, the essence of which will be based on a smaller Executive for work in between the current two-monthly general meetings and the development of a set of working groups.
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
3) RECOMMENDATION

IWALC: Objectives

Clause 2
The aims and objectives of the Association shall be consistent with the objectives of the National Association of Local Councils, hereinafter to be referred to as 'The National Association', and in particular:

To represent the interests of the first tier of statutory local government, comprising of Town and Parish Councils in the Isle of Wight, hereinafter called collectively 'Local Councils'.

To provide support and co-ordination to all aspects of the work of Local Councils, as embodied in the following principles of good local government.

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IWALC: Objectives

- To promote the health, safety and well being, both material and cultural of the people in its various communities.
- To attract and hold the interests of its citizens.
- To develop inherent strength to deal with, and work with all other tiers of local, regional and national government.
- To adapt itself to change in response to the needs of citizens in the local community.
- To protect, consolidate and develop the existing rights, privileges and functions of Local Councils.


