

**TOWN COUNCIL MEETING** 

**REPORT 106/18**

The purpose of this paper is to record developments since the last meeting not requiring an Agenda item at this meeting.

#### No. DETAILS

#### 1) FIRST AID HUT LEASE

The revised lease was agreed by the Assets & Services Working Group at its 31 October meeting and has been signed and delivered to the Isle of Wight Council as agreed by the Town Council in Minute 112/18 of its meeting of 8 October.

## 2) VENTNORVILLE ORGANISERS

- a) We have been asked by the organisers of this year's Ventnorville event to pass on their appreciation of the £500 contribution to its costs.
- b) The Assets & Services Working Group agreed to provide free car parking on the Saturday and Sunday of the event in the Dudley Road, Market Street and Pound Lane car parks.

#### 3) GREEN ROOM

- The Assets and Services Group has accepted a quotation for the redecoration of the Green Room areas.
- b) The work will be carried out in early January.

#### 4) UPPER VENTNOR COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

- a) Councillor Jason Mack and I joined the Upper Ventnor Community Association Committee for the latest of our six-weekly discussions on Monday 5 November.
- b) Discussion items included the filling of the vacancy for a Lowtherville town councillor, the proposals for the new Ventnor/Wroxall Ward. The welcome improvements to Park Avenue and the youth work activities in St Margaret's Hall.
