No. DETAILS

I) MAINTENANCE MANAGER

We're delighted that our new Maintenance Manager, Brian Roberts, joined us on Monday 27 March and is already fully engaged with the range of responsibilities that come with the post.

2) LIBRARY SIGNAGE & OPEN DAY

- a) The new sign *The Ventnor Library* is now in place reflecting the successful partnership basis on which the service now operates.
- b) The Friends of Ventnor Library have taken the lead in planning the Library's Open Day that takes place on Tuesday 18 April.

3) REGENERATION (A)

- a) Our second meeting the first was six weeks earlier with the Isle of Wight Council's recently appointed Director of Regeneration Chris Ashman was on 27 March.
