



CHANGES TO PERMITTED PARKING

The purpose of this Report is to ask Members to determine their response to the current consultation on Island Roads' fourteen Traffic Orders proposed for implementation in Ventnor in relation to parking in eight of the town's roads.

NO. DETAILS

1) BACKGROUND

- a) Following an Island-wide review of parking arrangements Island Roads have now opened a consultation on its proposed changes set out in a set of new Traffic Orders.
 - b) The proposed Traffic Orders for Ventnor involve changes to parking in eight of the town's roads: the Esplanade, Steep hill Road, Victoria Street, Leeson Road, Shore Road, Albert Street, St Catherine Street and Park Avenue.
