Sustainability and Biodiversity working group public engagement exercise 2022

Background

In the coming decades tackling climate change and biodiversity losses will be one of humanities greatest challenges.

Ventnor Town Council's Sustainability and Biodiversity working group propose to conduct a public engagement exercise on these topics with the following objectives.

- Increase the council's knowledge about local residents' concerns.
- Identify positive themes and projects in the town that can be built upon.
- Identify individuals that can contribute or lead on projects.
- Discover reservoirs of local knowledge and capacity.
- Networking to help residents meet likeminded people in their community.
- Inform public with high level overview of situation and possibilities.

The information received from this exercise will help the working group submit an action plan to the council.

Practicalities

- 1. The S&B group propose to host four events, one in each of the discrete areas of the town, Ventnor, Bonchurch, Lowtherville and St Lawrence.
- 2. The objective will be to conclude the events before the end of November.
- 3. The topic headings are laid out in the separate document Sustainability and Biodiversity working group public engagement exercise 2022 Topic headings
- 4. Each of the four events will have a Cllr in charge of venue organisation and the running of the evening.
- 5. These events will be promoted using the councils' channels Website, email, clerks' column and Facebook, and with leaflets and posters as required.
- 6. Methodology: the events will be run using principles drawn from peoples' assemblies' techniques with an introduction session, small group working and reconvening to share outputs.
- 7. Costs: We request the provision of a £250 budget for venue hire and refreshment.
