The Isle of Wight Council (Bellevue Road, Ventnor, Isle of Wight) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order No 1 2022

Island Roads on behalf of The Isle of Wight Council give notice that from 0900 hours on Monday 27 June 2022 until 1700 hours on Friday 8 July 2022, or when the works has been completed, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Bellevue Road, between its junctions with Zig Zag Road and the Burlington Hotel. The alternative route will be signposted locally. The closure is required for safety during utility works.

The Isle of Wight Council (Church Road, Havenstreet, Isle of Wight) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order No 2 2022
