COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WORKING GROUP

Tony McCarthy got the Group's Thursday evening session underway as usual with his report on his work since the last meeting. His success in securing a 50%reduction from Island Roads in their road closure charges for the Carnival was welcomed as was news of the more than £1,700 collected via the red buckets for the Carnival Committee's remarkable work. It was also good to hear that both the Mountbatten Hospice and the RNIB are resuming their use of our Green Room. He informed us of the recruitment by Barnardos of a one-year post for a Community Activator working 28.5 hours a week between Ventnor and Shanklin. Tony's update on support for local residents included the information that in the year to June the town's Foodbank had provided food for 582 people and the membership of the Community Pantry at Babybox was now over 120.

Other Agenda items included a review of Ventnor Day 2022, discussion of the Allotments, David's update on the Family Voice project and a report of the latest meeting the Mayor, Alison and I had with County Councillors Gary Peace and Rodney Downer.

VENTNOR HAVEN GOES OUT TO TENDER

The Isle of Wight Council will today publish an



invitation to tender for the management of the Ventnor Haven for five years from 1 April 2023. Responsibilities will include:

supervision of the harbour, management of the berths, collection of berthing income, maintenance of the pontoons and harbour infrastructure, full insuring liability, reporting all accidents and incidents, provision of monthly reports, compliance with the Port Marine Safety Code (PMSC), compliance with all relevant legislation, including Health and Safety, Statutory returns to the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) and removal of seaweed in accordance with the current MMO licence.
