CARRIAGEWAY IMPROVEMENT WORKS IN BONCHURCH SHUTE, VENTNOR

We are writing to let you know about the carriageway works due to take place in your local area shortly, and to provide you with some information and guidance in relation to what will happen during the works, to enable you to plan accordingly.

Timing of the works:

- Carriageway works commencing on **Monday 6th March 2023** for approximately 5 days.
- Works will take place during the day between 07:30 and 17:00 hours.
- There will be a road closure in place at all times until completion of the works.
- Diversionary routes will be signposted.

Island Roads will be undertaking areas of improvement works under a 24-hour road closure between The Pitts and Bonchurch Village Road. During these works no on-street parking and no vehicle access will be permitted within the areas of closure.

Please note, there are a variety of factors including inclement weather and emergency works that may affect the timing of works. Please watch the on-site boards for information on start date, duration and any changes to the scheme (example shown below).

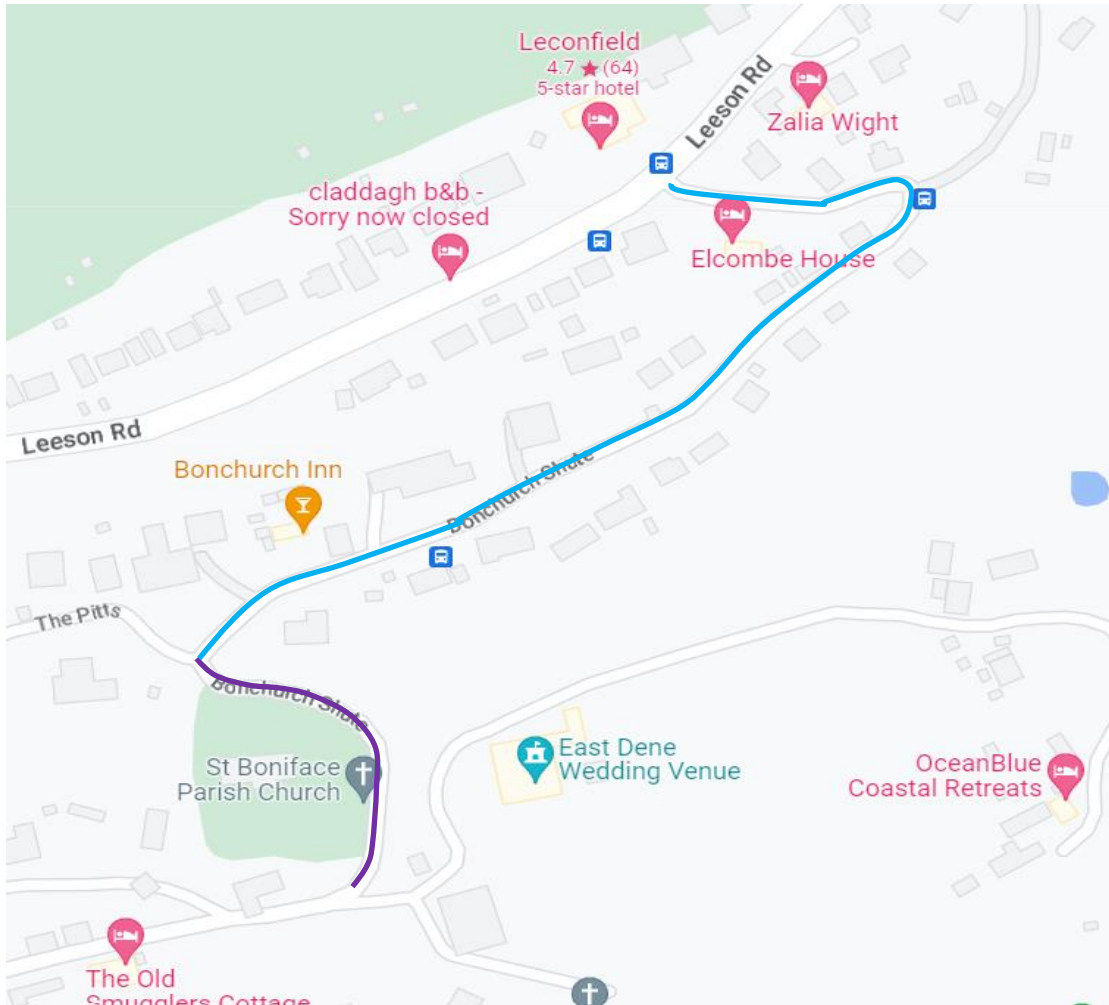
IMPROVEMENT WORKS

Estimated duration:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Monday 06/03/2023 – Friday 10/03/2023 (approximately)
Additional Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The works will be carried out under a 24-hour road closure for safety.• Access to residents within the areas of works will only be permitted when safe to do so.• An additional “soft closure” will be in place between The Pitts and Leeson Road with access for residents only.

In an emergency

We work closely with the emergency services to inform them of works taking place across the Island and will assist the emergency services to safely pass through the site, should they need to access the works area in the event of an emergency.

Parking/vehicle removal

To enable us to complete our work successfully and avoid any damage to vehicles, we would ask for your cooperation in removing your vehicle from the area before the start of the works and parking your vehicle outside of the road closure during the period of works.

We will unfortunately need to remove any vehicles that remain in the location of the road closure, and relocate them to a safe alternative location nearby, if they have not been removed prior to the works

commencing. In these circumstances, you will need to locate your removed vehicle by contacting our help centre and providing them with your registration details. Please note that Island Roads have the authority to remove vehicles from the carriageway in these circumstances, and costs may be incurred to the registered keeper if a vehicle needs to be removed from the carriageway and relocated.

If you have off-street parking your vehicle may remain on your driveway or garage, provided you do not need to use the vehicle for the duration of the works. If you will require the use of your vehicle, we would ask you to relocate it to another area outside of the road closure prior to the works taking place, as access during the works will be restricted.

Waste collection

If these works coincide with your usual domestic waste collection day, please ensure your waste is on the kerbside before 7am to enable its early collection.

Commercial waste

If these works coincide with your usual arrangements for commercial waste collection, please contact your service provider directly to make alternative arrangements with them.
