## 18/25 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING – 29 MAY 2025

## It was unanimously resolved to:

## 19/25 COMMUNITY ORCHARD MAINTENANCE

The Town Clerk gave an overview of the paper. There was a discussion about the options for watering.

## It was agreed that:

Staff would monitor the weather and engage the contractor to water the trees as necessary.

## 20/25 COMMUNITY ORCHARD WORKING GROUP

## It was agreed to:

Approve the Working Group with one of the 3 Councillors being Cllr Steve Cooper. The Town Clerk would ask other Councillors if they wish to fill the other 2 vacancies.

#### 21/25 No.31 Bus

Cllr Steve Milford suggested working towards a new contract in time for 1 April 2026 with a start date of 1 July 2026. It was suggested following the same pattern for the journeys. The Isle of Wight Council would want details of the number of journeys and routes. It was suggested that the current 3 days could be extended to 4 days to run on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Cllr Milford suggested starting to put a contract together to look at the daily rate.

Set up a Working Group for the No.31 Bus to progress the tendering process and grant discussions. The Town Clerk to draft a Terms of Reference for the next meeting.
